◆ **Creating safe and reliable food**

- Develop and produce dried noodles that store for long periods of time while working to reduce food waste
- Provide food banks with products that are close to their expiry date
- Provide safe and reliable food products based on the FSC 22000 certification we obtained



◆ **Building comfortable work places**

In addition to receiving the Kagawa Work Style Reform Promotion Declaration and aiming to increase efficiency by promoting automation, we strive to create workplaces that promote the inclusion of women and allow employees to care for their children and loved ones.

[Main initiatives]

- Helped draft the Kagawa Work Style Reform Promotion Declaration
- Helped draft the Kagawa Women's Kira Support Declaration
- Certified Child-Rearing Action Plan Business
- Advocate for employees to reduce overtime work and take PTO



◆ **Environmental initiatives**

We work to reduce our CO2 footprint and generated waste so that we can reduce our impact on the environment.

[Main initiatives]

- Install low-energy boilers
- Gradually transition company vehicles to hybrid vehicles and change fluorescent lights to LED lighting
- Promote the use of renewable products
